

HERIT-DATA aims to identify innovative solutions, with the support of new technologies and big data, to reduce the negative impacts of tourism on cultural and natural heritage sites. The project started in April 2018 and will last until March 2022.

The project will be implemented in five pilot sites in Croatia, France, Greece, Italy and Spain, where specific data will be collected and analyzed through a dedicated platform.

Those data will be used by policy makers to design new policies and to better organize tourist flows.
