

HERIT-DATA: innovative solutions to better manage tourism flows impact on cultural and natural heritage sites through technologies and big data

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The HERIT-DATA Project is an European initiative - part of the Interreg Mediterranean programme - and co-financed by the European Regional Development Fund (ERDF) - aimed at identifying innovative solutions for better tourism flow management. HERIT-DATA exploits new technologies and Big Open Data for reducing the impacts of tourism on cultural and natural heritage sites.

This project is involving six pilot sites i.e. Dubrovnik (Croatia), Pont du Gard (Occitanie Region, France), Ancient Olympia (Western Greece Region, Greece), Florence (Tuscany Region, Italy), Valencia (Valencia Region, Spain) and Mostar (Bosnia Herzegovina). The project started in February 2018 will end in January 2022.

The online event will be the opportunity for sharing the different experiences of project partners, and new tourism policies presented by the policy makers. Protagonist of the event will also be the project platform, virtual home of the pilot, where data are ingested and flow management process are created.
